## Philosophy with Children at the XXV World Congress of Philosophy

The XXV World Congress of Philosophy (WCP), convening 1-8 August 2024 in Rome, Italy, includes thematic sections relevant to Philosophy for/with Children. In particular, Section 81, "Philosophy with Children", which is supposed to be scheduled in the first four days of the Programme, that is from 1-4 August.

In consideration of the unfortunate loss of the Hamburg Conference scheduled for July 2024, the ICPIC Executive Committee (EC) recommends that ICPIC members take the XXV World Congress of Philosophy as an opportunity to share relevant scholarship. In addition, the ICPIC Executive Committee will convene an ICPIC General Meeting (AGM) during the WCP in Rome. However, it is important to note that the Philosophy with Children session at the WPC is not an ICPIC conference and is not intended to take the place of the conference planned for Hamburg.

In consideration of the fact that the PwC Session is co-chaired by ICPIC members and current president, a process of negotiation to enlarge and facilitate participation to the meeting was started by ICPIC EC. The WCP organizers positively agreed to offer a special low registration rate for ICPIC regular members to the whole WCP Programme. The registration procedure will be detailed in a specific communication. Considering these benefits, the EC invites ICPIC members to take part in the Rome event.

Persons wanting to present a paper for the "Philosophy with Children" Section 81 at the WCP may submit proposals directly at the Congress website (<a href="https://wcprome2024.com/paper/">https://wcprome2024.com/paper/</a>).

In addition to thematic sessions, the WCP invites proposals for panels/round tables (topic number 00, see <a href="https://wcprome2024.com/program-committee/round-tables/">https://wcprome2024.com/program-committee/round-tables/</a>). Persons wanting to propose a panel/round table may submit directly to the WCP website too.

Persons wanting to organize and propose a different round table related to Philosophy with Children or another topic may do so. In particular, The ICPIC Executive Committee is happy to post calls for round table participation on the ICPIC website and to share with other organizations (please send to <a href="mainto:marina.santi@unipd.it">marina.santi@unipd.it</a>; <a href="mainto:members@icpic.org">members@icpic.org</a> with the subject title "WCP-RTproposal" as soon as possible). If interested, we are also going to propose joint round tables with the thematic session 55 "Philosophy of Childhood", which is very close to the ICPIC interest too.

The following points may be helpful in considering options:

- The deadline for all proposal submissions (papers and round tables) is 1st February 2024. Presenters are strongly recommended to submit their proposal as soon as possible.
- 2. Undergraduate, graduate and PhD Students submitting paper proposals must use topic number 90.
- 3. Though the WCP website suggests that a panel/round table should last around two hours, depending on the number of participants, it is possible to schedule a panel/round table for two sessions (e.g. 2 morning sessions, or a morning or afternoon session).
- 4. All persons may submit a proposal for one paper presentation only. However, persons who are invited /accepted in a panel/round table may also present an individual paper.
- 5. The WPC accepts proposals for individual papers and for panels/round tables; it does not accept proposals for workshops.
- 6. All proposals must be submitted directly on the WCP website (see links above). **No submissions can be made on the ICPIC website**.
- 7. WCP participants (papers or round tables) **must be registered with the WCP**; ICPIC membership will not be considered as automatic registration to the WCP, nor is ICPIC

- membership required for submitting a proposal to the WCP session on Philosophy with Children.
- 8. According to the ICPIC Executive Committee request advanced to WCP organizers, ICPIC members (2023 and/or 2024 regular membership) have the benefit of a flat registration fee of 180 Euros. Discounted registration for students (€ 30 :-)) is available. A specific format for ICPIC members will be settled ASAP in the WCP website.
